Perhaps we do not know much about the chocolate bars that we usually consume. (1) Here are some tasty tips from Belgium's top chocolate makers. First, perhaps we do not want to touch the chocolate bar with our fingers, because **they** will soon be covered with dirty chocolate crumbs. If a chocolate starts to melt in your fingers, that's a good sign because it shows a high cocoa-butter content.

Now, maybe we want to know how to choose quality chocolate bars in the store. Look for chocolate with smooth luster, and be sure to shun dull or cracked pieces of those with a white "bloom" caused by too much heat or humidity. Ask for a sample and see whether it snaps crisply when bitten into. Avoid chocolates that are crumbly or mushy.

The next are some precautions in storing the chocolate we bought. Store fine (10) chocolate in dark, cool place way from damp, but not in refrigerator. And then, when we are about to consume them, be sure to check the "best before" date. Filled chocolates with cream should be consumed within two weeks, while others can last about two months. Now, enjoy your candy!

Over 40 years ago, George deMestral returned home from a walk in the country. As he took off his jacket, he found cockleburs clinging all over it. He had a lot of trouble picking off the burrs. As he got each burr off, he wondered why it stuck. George closely examined the burrs and his jacket. He found two important features. One was that the burrs had little hooks on their ends. The other was that the loops of cloth on his jacket had gotten caught on the hooks.

He figured out how to duplicate nature's way of fastening one thing to another. His discovery was named Velcro. The name came from a combination of the words velvet and crochet.

Today Velcro is made of sturdy material, usually a plastic. The hooks and loops make it possible for two strips of the same material to stick firmly together. Television host David Letterman demonstrated this fact by wearing a suit made of Velcro and sticking himself to a Velcro wall. Even though he was having fun with Velcro, what he did illustrated how well it works.

Velcro fasteners open and close easily, but they also hold tightly until they are pulled apart. These are qualities that appeal to parents of small children. Velcro fasteners make it easier for small children to dress themselves. The struggle with shoelaces can be put off for a few years. But this amazing fastener has many other possible uses. The plastics can withstand temperatures of up to 800 degrees. They are strong enough to be used in spaceships.
